MES Cairo 24-Hour Run Football Fundraising Event

We are excited to announce that as part of our 24-Hour Run event, we are also holding a football fundraising event. This will take place on the afternoon and evening of 20th March 2019. As Egypt is hosting the Africa Cup of Nations later on this year, this is a great way to celebrate that and to showcase the football skills of students, staff, alumni and parents for a great cause: the Magdi Yacoub Foundation.

There will be four tournaments taking place throughout the afternoon and evening: Key Stage 1, Key Stage 2, Y/G 7-10 and then culminating with a tournament for Y/G/DP 11-12 students and adults. Each tournament will be formatted for a maximum of 10 teams, and will have a similar round robin draw with semi-finals and finals. Medals will be presented to the winning team in each category.

In each competition there will be a LE 100 registration fee per player, with 100% of these proceeds going to our fundraising efforts for the Magdi Yacoub Foundation. Squads are a maximum of 10 players, with a minimum of seven, six or five depending on the competition that you are entering. This is an exciting chance for some competitive football matches, where you can invite family and friends to watch and enjoy the food stalls and event ambiance. The format to the day will be as follows:

3.00pm- 4.30 pm: Key Stage 1 Tournament

- 7-a-side teams (including a goalkeeper) with a squad of up to 10 players
- A team manager who must be at least 15 years old
- Teams can have male and/or female players

4.30pm-6.00pm: Key stage 2 Tournament

- 6-a-side teams (this includes a goalkeeper) with a squad of up to 10 players
- A team manager who must be at least 15 years old
- Teams can have male and/or female players

6.00pm-7.30pm: Y/G 7-10 Tournament

- 5-a-side teams (this includes a goalkeeper) with a squad of up to 10 players
- Manager for the team who can also be a player (must be at least 13 years old)
- Teams can have male and/or female players

7.30pm-9.30pm: Y/G/DP 11 and 12 plus adults

- 5-a-side teams (this includes a goalkeeper) with a squad of up to 10 players
- Manager for the team who can also be a player.
- Teams can have male and/or female players
