
Dear Parents,

Introducing MES Cairo Spirit Days December 2021

There will be a charity/fundraising theme associated with each Spirit Day which will be announced ahead of time. Participation is optional, but as the very purpose of the occasions is to celebrate our strength as a community, we encourage all staff and students to get involved by embracing the dress code, taking part in Spirit Day events and contributing to the nominated cause.

Monday 20 December 2021 will mark the first of MES Cairo Spirit Days.

Dress Code: T-shirt/sweater from a past school event or trip, featuring an MES Cairo logo. Such as, a Pink Day t-shirt from 2018, a Ski Trip hoodie from 2020 or a football team shirt from 2016. Contributions should be deposited in the 'Keep Egypt Warm' collection boxes which will be staffed on the day - students making a deposit will be given a sticker to verify to the teachers that they are eligible to wear non-uniform items.

We look forward to celebrating school spirit whilst supporting the Egyptian Food Bank in their plight to make a positive difference for the benefit of the country's most needy.
