## Keep Egypt Warm

Items can be delivered by students and staff on their 'in-school' days, or, delivered to Gate 1 between 8.30am-12.30pm Saturday-Thursday. The advantage of having students bring items into school themselves is that class points (FS1-Y2) or house points (Y4-Y/G/DP12) can be earned with each item donated. The final day for collection will be the last day of Term 1: Thursday 17 December 2020.

We will work closely with the Egyptian Food Bank and the Egyptian Clothing Bank to sort donated items and ensure they are distributed to the schools we sponsor and their communities.

To add another dimension to the campaign, and to make up for our postponement of the 24hr Run 2020 event we had planned for last March, we will coincide our KEEP EGYPT WARM efforts with a 24hr Run initiative in the final two weeks of Term 1. You are encouraged to log into the Family Portal to order a 24hr Run t-shirt just as you did with our recent PINK DAY. All proceeds from t-shirt sales will be donated to our KEEP EGYPT WARM campaign.

Students may wear their 24hr Run t-shirt instead of their uniform PE t-shirt during these special two weeks, as well as on the dates noted above which start and finish the event.
