OUR SCHOOL CAMPUS

The school campus is situated in the clean, modern and thriving New Cairo area in a modern facility that is divided into two main areas for Primary and Secondary students.

Our students enjoy a large sports field, playing courts, a competition pool, a large 450 seat Theatre, and well-equipped Art, Technology and Science labs. They are offered a rich tapestry of opportunities for extra-curricular enrichment as part of our After School Activities programme including MES Cairo Pioneers, National Honor Society, and International Awards.

The weather in Egypt is warm throughout the spring and summer. Residents are blessed with sunshine on almost every day of the year, whilst also enjoying the full range of seasons without the climate reaching unbearable extremes.

Our teacher parents enjoy the fun-filled community offered to them by the MES Cairo Kids Club, run by current teacher parents. The Kids Club provides regular opportunities for family gatherings and outings, including an annual desert trip, Christmas and Halloween parties and an annual overnight trip to a poolside retreat.

MES Cairo – Summary of Package and Benefits for Overseas-Hire Teachers (for more details refer to the Sample Conditions of Employment)

Contracts

Initial 2-year contract with the option of annual renewal pending satisfactory performance review.

Salary

70% of teachers' salaries are paid in either GBP or USD, as agreed at point of hire. The remaining 30% will be paid in Egyptian LE converted at the rate applicable on the day of transfer to the bank. Staff are paid on the 26th of every month or the last working day of the month whichever comes first.

Gratuity/Service Bonus

For the first three years half a month's salary is earned as gratuity. From the fourth year to the ninth year one month's salary is earned for each year served. From year 10 onwards half a month's salary is earned as gratuity.

Sick leave

We maintain high attendance expectations for staff and students. That said, there is support available if/when you become unwell. When an appropriate medical certificate is produced, the first six days of absence do not affect your salary.

Accommodation

Teachers receive a housing contribution which is paid monthly. Many teachers choose to supplement their housing allowance, depending on their chosen location and style of housing. Teaching couples each receive their own housing allowance as individuals. Teachers rent apartments independently of the school but our accommodation team offers ample assistance to new recruits, including a website of available options.

Transport

Optional transport is provided to and from school daily for teaching staff residing in serviced locations. Our comfortable and air-conditioned staff buses are for use by staff only. Staff with families who wish to travel to school with their children make alternative, independent transport arrangements.

Settling-in Allowance

Staff that are new to Cairo are entitled to a nominal settling in allowance upon their first arrival in Cairo; some local currency cash for incidentals.

Medical Insurance

Staff members and their children are covered by a local medical insurance policy that covers essential medical treatments and emergencies within its limit. International care coverage with BUPA can also be purchased through the School and the School covers 50% of the Essential care monthly premium for employees.



Waived School Fees

Teaching staff who enrol their children in the school are not required to pay tuition fees, registration fees, or busing fees.

Air Passage

Economy class tickets are provided for the teacher's arrival to Cairo at the beginning of the contract. For returning staff, a set allowance for a round trip ticket to the nominated 'home' destination (as per contract) is provided during the summer break. For non-returning staff a set allowance for a one way ticket is provided. The allowance is based on the average price of a round trip ticket to various airports in the country of origin.

Embassies

We maintain excellent relations with Diplomatic Missions in Cairo including the British and US Embassies. All staff are encouraged to register online with their Embassy upon arrival in Cairo.
